# Children's Defense Fund Health Coverage for All Children: Idaho



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## All Children Need Health Coverage that is Affordable, Comprehensive, and Simple.

#### Health Coverage for Idaho's Children:

- 46,000 children are uninsured (10.3% of all children).
- 146,406 children are enrolled in Medicaid.
- 42,208 children are enrolled in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

#### How affordable is health coverage for Idaho's children?<sup>†</sup>

- CHIP eligibility is up to 185 percent of poverty (\$41,348 for a family of four).
- Medicaid eligibility is 133 percent of poverty (\$29,726).

### How simple are enrollment procedures in CHIP and Medicaid for Idaho's children?

- Simplification procedures:
  - 12 month continuous eligibility
  - Administrative verification of income
  - No face-to-face interview
  - No asset test
  - Joint application
- Barriers that remain:
  - 6 month waiting period
  - No presumptive eligibility—which forces children to wait until their application is processed before they can see a doctor
