

# Health Coverage for All Children: Michigan

#### All Children Need Health Coverage that is Affordable, Comprehensive, and Simple.

#### **Health Coverage for Michigan's Children:**

- 147,000 children are uninsured (5.9% of all children).
- 1,059,986 children are enrolled in Medicaid.
- 69,796 children are enrolled in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

## How affordable is health coverage for Michigan's children? †

- Children's eligibility is up to 200 percent of poverty (\$44,700 for a family of four).
- Medicaid eligibility is 185 percent of poverty (\$41,348) for children 0-1, and 150 percent of poverty (\$33,525) for children 1-19.

### How simple are enrollment procedures in CHIP and Medicaid for Michigan's children?

- Simplification procedures:
  - 12-month continuous eligibility
  - Administrative verification of income
  - Presumptive eligibility
  - No face-to-face interview
  - No asset test
  - Joint application
- Barriers that remain:
  - 6 month waiting period
